# Syndicated auction results of new 20-year Udibono Nov'43

- Yesterday, Banxico held a syndicated auction offering the new 20-year
   Udibono for a total amount of UDIS 1.7 billion (US\$ 13.2 billion)
- The security has a 3.25% coupon rate (semi-annually payments) and will mature on November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2043
- The settlement date will be on Monday, April 24<sup>th</sup>
- In line with our expectations, this security registered a 4.50% settlement rate, equivalent to +5bps with respect to yesterday's close of Udibono Nov'35 (previous reference)
- The total amount offered was UDIS 1.7 billion; however, at the time of this release we still do not have information about the number of investors that participate in the transaction or the demand for this security

- The next issuance date for the 20-year Udibono in the <u>2Q23 auction</u> calendar is on May 2<sup>nd</sup>
